TSCA Statement of Compliance

On January 6, 2021, US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) passed new rules banning or restricting five substances added to the TSCA list as active substances in the TSCA inventory of chemical substances. Recent rule changes to the [Toxic Substances Control Act \(TSCA\)](#) have put the electronics industry on high alert.

The 5 substances and associated CAS numbers are:

- 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP) (CAS 732-26-3)
- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE) (CAS 1163-19-5)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD) (CAS 87-68-3)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP) (CAS 133-49-3)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)) (CAS 68937-41-7)

Flex Power Modules hereby confirms that all existing and active products within its range of DC/DC Power Modules fulfill the TSCA requirement, and do not contain any of the above substances.
