TSCA Statement of Compliance

On January 6, 2021, US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) passed new rules banning or restricting five substances added to the TSCA list as active substances in the TSCA inventory of chemical substances. Recent rule changes to the <u>Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)</u> have put the electronics industry on high alert.
